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EVENTS THE PARENTS ASSOCIATION HELP OUT WITH DURING THE SCHOOL YEAR

- Mock Interviews*** A very important event for 6th year pupils. We ask parents and friends of the school with expertise in the pupils chosen professions to help give these short 20 minute interviews and feedback. This is why we ask you to outline your career area eg Doctor, Primary School Teacher etc.
- Careers Evening*** An event we run for 5th year pupils where we ask parents and friends of the school to come in be available to answer the children's questions about the careers they have an interest in. The idea is that students get to talk to people from many different career backgrounds on the night. Again we need to know your career area.
- Social Networking** This in an event that is currently run for parents of 2nd year pupils, with the idea of getting to meet other parents of pupils in the year. Help would entail contacting other parents in the year, organising spot prizes etc.
- Shindig** This is the fun afternoon and evening event that the Student Council runs on the Friday of the week prior to the end of the summer term. Helpers are always wanted to supervise the bouncy castles/slides and walk the grounds to help the staff while the disco is taking place. We run this on a rota basis on the day.
- Recycle Uniform Sales** This event is run at the end of the Christmas and Summer terms with a view to collecting up good quality, re-usable uniform items that are no longer required. They are then sold on at a good price to other students. The profit made goes for the use of the Student Council for the benefit of all the pupils. Unwanted uniform items can be donated at any time via reception.
