Fees for Associated Board and Royal Irish Academy of Music examinations, once entered into, are not refundable or transferable as this is beyond our control.

If a student does not turn up for an individual lesson the teacher will, at first, try to find them. This is not possible for joint lessons. If a student does not turn up for several lessons, without explanation, the parents or guardians will be contacted. Students should always keep in touch with their teachers letting them know why they were absent and arranging their next lesson.

If you wish to apply for lessons please review this form carefully, and in full, prior to completion and return to the School with payment. Payment can be issued via cheque or bank transfer.
