

Uniform Code



- 1) All pupils must travel to and from school in full uniform.
- 2) School jackets and school scarves [snood] must be worn by pupils traveling to and from school.
- 3) Formal school uniform or school tracksuits must be worn when traveling to matches.
- 4) Pupils may wear school branded clothing after classes finish for the day.
- 5) Pupils may wear the informal casual dress, as listed below, to tea and prep.
- 6) Boarders may wear neat casuals on Saturday and Sunday except for evening Chapel. The same applies to day pupils attending the Saturday programme or school events at the weekend.

School Uniform for Boys	Unacceptable breaches of the code
Dark grey school trousers.	Light grey trousers. Skin tight trousers. Black trousers.
Standard white boy's school shirt and tie – top button done up.	Top button open.
Navy blue v-neck pullover with school crest.	Jumper too small. Torn jumper.
Plain standard black leather shoes or navy leather deck shoes only.	Boots. Canvas shoes. Runners. Two tone shoes.
Plain matching black or navy school socks.	Ankle/trainer socks.

Boarders must wear a white shirt and school blazer for formal wear.

School Uniform for Girls	Unacceptable breaches of the code
School skirt must be worn to the knee. Girls' grey school trousers optional.	School skirt worn above the knee.
Standard white girl's school shirt and tie – top button must be done up.	Top button open.
Navy blue v-neck pullover with school crest.	Jumper too small or torn.
Plain standard flat black leather shoes or navy leather deck shoes only.	Boots. Canvas shoes. Runners. Two tone shoes. Slingbacks. Platform shoes greater than 5 cm.
Black or navy knee length socks or opaque tights.	Torn tights.

- Full uniform must be worn at all times; students are expected to have shirts/blouses tucked in and buttoned up.
- Hair colours must be natural and worn in styles deemed appropriate for school. Hair must not be shorter than a No 3 cut. Any student who requires further direction about what is an appropriate hairstyle must consult his/her Houseperson before changing hairstyle.
- Boys must be clean shaven at all times.
- Nail varnish and make-up should not be worn at any time in school.
- The wearing of jewellery, apart from a wrist watch and/or small single stud earring in each lobe, is strictly prohibited.
- Trainers/Canvas shoes of any kind are NOT acceptable as part of the school uniform; parents are thus advised to avoid purchasing shoes through Sports Shops/online Sports Outlets.
- Belts, if worn, should only be plain black.
- Trainer socks in any colour are not permitted.
- **All items of the school uniform are available to purchase from Uniformity. We cannot advise that items purchased anywhere else will be in accordance with the Uniform Code**

PLEASE ENSURE THAT EVERY ITEM OF YOUR UNIFORM AND P.E. KIT IS MARKED WITH YOUR NAME.

The school reserves the right in all cases to make a final judgement regarding acceptable standards of uniform and presentation.

EVENING UNIFORM

Uniform for pupils from teatime to bedtime:

All pupils can wear their school uniform or they can wear the following agreed casual uniform. This is a compromise and a privilege. If the uniform code is breached by a pupil during teatime and bedtime then the pupil involved will revert to the full school time uniform for a period of time. This will be noted in the uniform section of the duty book on a weekly basis.

Casual Uniform:

A school branded hoodie. A loose t-shirt of their choice. Plain jeans or plain tracksuit bottoms, which must not be ripped. Proper shoes, decks or runners.

Unacceptable Evening Uniform:

Flip flops, slippers, Uggs, jeggings, skins, tight leggings, tight tops and hats must not be worn.
