I hope you are all well. As mentioned in the Headmaster's general email today please note the following:

Assessments

Assessments continue until May 14th. There will a normal timetable of classes May 17th-21st with one hour classes from May 24th - 28th. Further detail on the arrangements and expectations for the period after the 14 May will be provided. However, in principle, the students will have 3 options during the last two weeks:

- Attend Class
- Attend supervised
- Remain home

If a student remains home on any day the parent **MUST** email absence@thekingshospital.ie for student registration purposes and parents' peace of mind.

Leaving Cert Portal

Information has been sent to the school this afternoon on the LC portal. An important change is that **all students must now log back into the portal** to confirm their choices, even if they have not changed since March.

- The portal reopens on Tuesday April 27 at 12pm.
- Students have the opportunity to review and finalise their level selection and their choices of examinations, Accredited Grades or both.
- All candidates are required to complete this process, even if their choices have not changed since March.
