



The King's Hospital School Overseas Travel Scheme 2019/2020

For the coming academic year 2019/2020, the school is offering a fully inclusive Overseas Travel Scheme for **€650**.

This includes:

1. Travel to and from the airport for; the beginning of the school year; the October midterm break, Christmas Holidays, February mid-term break (or TY work experience) and Easter Holidays, end of the school year including state examinations.
2. Travel to and from the arrival/departure gates at the airport with of a member of staff.
3. A text message will be sent to the designated parent/guardian informing them of the safe arrival/ departure of their child at the airport.
4. All drivers are known to The King's Hospital School and have been Garda vetted.
5. Parents may accompany their child on the school transport when travelling to the school for the start of term.

Important Information:

1. Where a parent has not subscribed to *The King's Hospital School Overseas Travel Scheme* the Guardian must accompany the student to and from the airport.
2. Students are not permitted to travel unaccompanied in a Taxi or on public transport to or from the airport.
3. The school will extend its opening and closing times on the day of and before school exeats to - 6.30am to 11.30pm- in order to facilitate flight times. Any flights requiring the student to depart/arrive at the school outside of these times cannot be facilitated, due to the disruption that would be caused to other students and staff. If a flight time requires the student to exit or enter the school outside of these times, alternative accommodation must be provided by the Guardian.
4. Please forward all travel arrangements via *Boardingware* TWO WEEKS IN ADVANCE OF TRAVEL DATES we cannot guarantee the service when information is given in late.
5. Any additional Travel required out of the official school exeats will be charged **an additional fee of €100** one way, this includes staff supervision to check in/out and transfer. Pre-payment and two-week's notice is essential to avail of this.
6. This is an all-inclusive service. No refunds will be issued for trips not taken or cancelling the service.
