



LC2021 info: Results Day, Script viewing, CAO, Support

Dear all

I hope you have enjoyed the summer break. I imagine you are eager to receive your Leaving Cert results next Friday, September 3rd, and the subsequent CAO offers on September 7th, for those of you planning to enrol in Irish Universities this year. Please remember that your leaving cert results in no way define you as a person and you now have your whole life ahead of you, with many choices in the paths you can take, to arrive at the career or life you have imagined for yourself.

Please find some information below extracted from a DES circular sent to the Headmaster, that is available to view in more detail on the linked websites; details on viewing scripts and appeals, CAO reminder and school support that is available to you.

1. Extract from Department of Education circular

Issued to candidates this week 'A Short Guide to the Accredited Grades Data Collection, National Standardisation and Quality Assurance Processes'

On Wednesday 25 August, candidates will be alerted by text and email to the publication of a Short Guide to the Accredited Grades Data Collection, National Standardisation and Quality Assurance Processes which provides further information about the system of Accredited Grades. The Short Guide will also be published on <http://www.gov.ie/LeavingCertificate.gov.ie> and on the SEC's website www.examinations.ie.

The Short Guide includes the timetable for accessing more detailed information about the provisional results; the dates for applying to view scripts; the dates of viewing scripts; and the deadline for making an appeal application. This is the first time that candidates have been provided with this information. School authorities are requested to use their communication channels to bring the guide to the attention of candidates. It should be noted that a Candidate Information Guide on Results and Appeals will be issued to candidates closer to the issue date for the results.
